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Stichting **The Fix Media Foundation** aims to support free press and media in Ukraine and Eastern Europe, and to build a more resilient and connected European media community.

Policy Plan

The foundation aims to fulfil its objectives by:

- Providing grants to journalism organisations and journalists in need;
- Connecting and networking international donors, governments, NGOs, civil society organisations, journalism organisations and journalists;
- Organising events, both online and online;
- Raising awareness of, and advocating for, media freedom issues in Ukraine and the wider European community

Our **multi-annual plan** (Beleidsplan) is as follows:

2023

- Primary focus on continued support for Ukrainian media, both from direct grants and regranting from other foundations and donations.
- Total estimated budget for the organisation: **€850,000**

2024

- Balanced focus (50/50) on support for Ukrainian media and investments into systemic and disruptive media with a strong focus on Central and Eastern Europe.
- Total estimated budget for the organisation: **€900,000**

2025

- Primary focus on investments in systemic and disruptive media with a strong focus on Central and Eastern Europe. Support for Ukrainian media will continue as required.
- Total estimated budget for the organisation: **€950,000**

2026

- Primary focus on investments in systemic and disruptive media with a strong focus on Central and Eastern Europe. Further emergency support for Ukrainian media is not foreseen, but could change depending on the geopolitical situation.
- Total estimated budget for the organisation: **€1,000,000**

Board and Governance

The Foundation was incorporated on the 9th of May 2022. We are in the process of registering as a ANBI (a Public Benefit Organisation) in The Netherlands. The foundation has an office in Verdunplein 17, Unit C2722, 5627SZ, Eindhoven, the Netherlands.

Registration

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Financial

In general, the board has agreed to try and maintain the operating costs (non-project overheads) of the organisation at less than 10% of the overall budget (income, grants, etc.).

As an ANBI foundation, 90% of its revenue will be directed towards its mission.

Directors and advisory board members receive no remuneration for their work.

All financial protocols are in place, for overseeing any transfers and transactions above 1500 euros.
